

Summary of Scholarship Contest Key Rules

- Open to all high school and college students, enrolled or planning to enroll within a skilled-trades curriculum during 2019-2020, in northern Michigan (north of Lansing).
- You must be either: (1) at least eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time of entry; or (2) at least sixteen (16) years of age at the time of entry and have a parent or legal guardian's consent and supervision to enter Otsego County Habitat's scholarship contest.
- Entries are only valid for the current year that they are submitted and not carried over into the next school year.
- Projects must be labeled and submitted to the Otsego Habitat ReStore no later than October 25th, 2019 at 4:00 p.m.
- One (1) entry allowed per person/email address/household. A winner(s) will be chosen and notified on November 25th, through a tally of the votes from our ReStore customers.
- Scholarships will be awarded directly to the winners. Winners will be notified by phone call and posted on www.otsegohabitat.org.

Complete Official Rules

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SCHOLARSHIP(S). A PURCHASE WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. ODDS OF WINNING WILL DEPEND ON THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ELIGIBLE ENTRIES (PROJECTS) RECEIVED AS OF THE APPLICABLE DRAWING DATE DEADLINE. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

Otsego County Habitat for Humanity Skilled-Trades Scholarship begins on September 5, 2019 at 12:00 AM Eastern Time ("ET") and ends on October 25th, 2019 at 4:00 PM ET for an entry. (Your project must be dropped off to the Otsego Habitat ReStore located at 526 Edelweiss Village Parkway, Gaylord, no later than 4:00 p.m.).

ELIGIBILITY: The Otsego Habitat Skilled-Trades Scholarship contest is open only to legal residents of the United States who are (a) at least eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time of entry; or (b) at least sixteen (16) years of age at the time of entry and have a parent or legal guardian's consent and supervision to enter the Scholarship Contest; and (c) have a valid United States Social Security Number.

The Scholarship Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations. Void in Puerto Rico, all U.S. territories and possessions, overseas military installations and where prohibited or restricted by law. **NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.**

PRIVACY INFORMATION: The information obtained from your survey or entry in the Otsego Habitat Scholarship Contest may be used by Otsego County Habitat for Humanity and ReStore to promote construction and skilled-trades education. Personal contact information is collected to notify winner(s) and verify their identity. This information **will not be sold or shared with** our partners or any other entity. However, Otsego County Habitat and ReStore would like to contact each participant either by mail or email about our special promotions or offers on occasion. If you prefer not to receive updates of special promotions and/or offers, please send an e-mail to office@otsegohabitat.org with the words “remove my name” in the subject line of the e-mail. HOW TO ENTER THE SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST: 1) Complete the scholarship interest/intent form posted on our website at www.otsegohabitat.org and either email it to office@otsegohabitat.org; or fax to (989) 731-4578; or mail to OCHFH, 526 Edelweiss Village Parkway, Gaylord, MI 49735, no later than September 20th, 2019, 5:00 p.m.

No other method of entry will be accepted. Limit one (1) entry per person/email address/household.

ODDS: Odds of winning the Scholarship (defined below) will depend on the number of Eligible Project Entries received into Otsego Habitat’s ReStore.

WINNER SELECTION: Projects will be displayed in Otsego County Habitat for Humanity ReStore from October 28th, 2019 through November 23rd, 2019. During this time, ReStore customers will vote for the projects. One (1) potential winner of the \$500 Scholarship and one (1) potential winner of the \$200 Scholarship will be selected by tallying the customer votes that are received in-store. Voting online won’t count. Announcement and instructions for the scholarship(s) will be made by telephone, posting on FACEBOOK and announced on Eagle Radio 101.5.

If the potential winner shall forfeit either of the scholarships a new winner will be selected from the remaining eligible project entries.

Scholarship: One (1) scholarship of \$500 cash will be awarded and one (1) scholarship of \$200 cash will be awarded.

PUBLICATION, LICENSE, AND RELEASE: By entering the Scholarship Contest and submitting an entry, each entrant: (a) agrees that his/her entry is an original work and they did not have any help in creating their entry. And that he/she owns all right, title and interest in the entry as of the date of submission or has all necessary rights and authorizations to submit their project; (b) agrees that his/her entry does not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity, or other intellectual or real property or other rights of any person or entity; (c) grants to Otsego County Habitat for Humanity and ReStore and each of their respective designees the perpetual and unlimited right and license to use, license, edit, modify, duplicate works from his/her entry throughout the world and in perpetuity, including, but not limited to, the right for Otsego County Habitat for Humanity & ReStore and Promotion Parties, as applicable, to publish, display, broadcast, distribute, reproduce, perform, and otherwise use and exploit the entry via the Internet or any other interactive media, on television, in print and/or any other media currently existing and hereafter developed and without limitation and without payment of any compensation to the entrant or his/her heirs and successors, (i) on its own or as part of any audiovisual or other production; (ii) to advertise any products, programming or services of Otsego County Habitat for Humanity and ReStore or for any other advertising, marketing, publicizing, and promotional purposes and in any materials related thereto; and/or (iii) for any other purpose whatsoever; and (d) release in perpetuity the Released Parties (defined below) from any claims, demands, losses, and liabilities of any nature arising out of or in any way connected with the entry, and the use thereof as permitted hereunder, including, but not limited to, claims of false endorsement or infringement of rights of publicity or privacy. In the event of cancellation, the Otsego County Habitat for Humanity & ReStore may elect to identify the Winner and award the Scholarship by way of random drawing from among all non-suspect, Eligible Entries received up to the time of such cancellation. The Otsego County Habitat for Humanity & ReStore also reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify these Official Rules for clarification purposes without materially affecting the terms and conditions of the Scholarship Contest.
